Sketchstorming

Prepare big sheets of paper that have both the concept and the criteria across the top. Create one sheet for each team for each brainstorming session. Hand out sketch templates for young designers to sketch ideas and attach to these big papers!

Concept	Criteria
Movement & Mobility	Sketch some ideas on how to allow free body movement through garment designs!
Wearable Electronics	Sketch ideas for an outfit with LED lights and other electronics that look cool. Remember to draw the circuits!
Thermal & Impact Protection	Sketch ideas for an outfit that will keep the wearer warm & dry and protect her from impact.
Garment Shapes	Sketch ideas for an outfit with creative silhouettes that look good and are functional. Think about movement, impact protection, thermal comfort, pattern shapes, and other functions as well as appearance!

For the final project or a culminating brainstorming session, prepare a big sheet of paper that looks like the image below. Have students apply multiple concepts to one design. Create one sheet for each team. Hand out sketch templates for young designers to sketch ideas and attach to these big papers!
